3. Have no prior criminal convictions (exception: traffic violations).
4. Possess a valid Social Security card and a picture ID.

Recommended courses to prepare for the Nursing Assistant Training class: OT 10 – Medical Terminology, ENGL 252 – Writing Improvement, ENGL 262 – Reading Improvement, High School biology or any college level biology course and a basic math course such as MATH 250 – College Arithmetic.
