This course will be offered online through Blackboard. Students will participate in online discussions in an asynchronous format weekly. Through the use of Blackboard each student will complete units of study that coincide with the reading material, powerpoints that are uploaded to blackboard and/or other materials that students will be directed to meet the objectives of the course.

Students will communicate with the instructor by participating in weekly discussion boards, email and phone conversations as necessary.

What provisions will you make for regular effective contact between instructors and students?

Students will use Blackboard Discussion Boards to communicate weekly with other students and instructor regarding the assigned reading materials and other assignments. Students will also have regular access to instructor through email and telephone as necessary. Online courses also allow for other students to communicate and respond to their classmates' questions which facilitate collaborative learning.

What other pertinent information should be shared with the committee?

This course is currently offered in a fully online format at Fresno City College as well as other community colleges in California. This course is part of the core Child Development Curriculum and required to complete an A.S. degree in Child Development. This course is also required for students to earn the Child Development Permit Matrix which is the teaching certificate required for employment in preschool and child care programs. Offering this course online will allow students who would prefer to attend Reedley College to remain part of our student body rather than seek coursework in non-traditional formats at other colleges.
