

## PROGRAM OF STUDY

### Spanish Associate in Arts Degree for Transfer

The Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer Degree prepares students for transfer to four-year Spanish programs. Students will acquire the Spanish language in a culturally rich environment and will possess the receptive skills (listening and reading) and the productive skills (speaking and writing) necessary to achieve communicative competence in order to pursue more advanced study of Spanish at a CSU campus. The Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer Degree is appropriate for students considering careers in fields such as education, translation and interpretation, business, social services and tourism.

To earn an Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer Degree, students must complete 60 semester units of CSU-transferable coursework, CSU-GE Breadth or IGETC requirements and 19-20 semester units within the major. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA, including grades of C or higher in each course taken to fulfill the major. The local graduation requirements are not required for the transfer degree. Students should consult with a counselor when planning to complete the degree for more information on university admission and transfer requirements.

**To earn the Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer Degree, students must complete the following requirements:**

**(1) 60 semester units or 90 quarter units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University, including both of the following:**

**(A) The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University General Education – Breadth Requirements.**

**(B) A minimum of 18 semester units or 27 quarter units in a major or area of emphasis, as determined by the community college district.**

**(2) A minimum grade point average of 2.0.**

**Associate Degrees for Transfer also require that students earn a C or better in all courses required for the major or area of emphasis. A “P” (Pass) grade is not an acceptable grade for courses in the major.**
