Course Objective:

Each student will understand and demonstrate the organizational and delivery techniques of a formal public presentation.

Course Outline:

Each student will present five organized speeches:

<u>Informative Speech:</u> Inform about a topic of interest citing two sources in outline. 6-7 min.

<u>Persuasive Speech:</u> Persuade about a topic of interest citing two sources in outline. 6-7 min.

<u>Demonstration Speech</u>: Demonstrate the process or technique for doing something. Your choice. 6-8 min.

<u>Entertainment/Oral Interpretation Speech:</u> Choice: Put together an oral interpretation speech using a piece of literature coupled with speaker analysis or;

Do a monologue, scene from a play, movie, etc. This is read with dramatics but **not** acted out. 7-8 min.

<u>Final Speech:</u> You may do a speech focused on some aspect of the profession you wish to enter. Example -- Teacher: Mini lesson plan <u>or</u> Business: Seminar presentation on some aspect of the profession, etc.

Impromptu Activities:

Impromptu speeches will be periodically performed on personal opinion topics provided by the instructor.

Grading:

All **four regular** speeches are one full letter grade <u>except</u>: Demonstration- one half letter grade.

Final Speech-- one and a half letter grade

Impromptu speeches and class participation -- one full letter grade.

Course grade is averaged from the above earned grades.

Attendance: Mandatory at all class meetings. More than 3 absences without prior instructor clearance and student will be asked to drop.
