## **TOPICS:**

1ST SEMESTER - Hanon No. 1 in all 12 major keys; 8-note scale patterns in keys of B,F,Bb,Eb,Ab,Db,Gb; I-IV-I-V7-I chord progression in all major keys; continued development of sightreading skills; preparation of recital piece. Written theory assignments will be given periodically.

<u>2ND SEMESTER</u> - Hanon No. 2 in all 12 major keys; triads in root position, 1st inversion and 2nd inversion in all 12 major keys; cross-over arpeggios of triads in root position, 1st inversion and 2nd inversion in all 12 major keys; continued development of sightreading skills; preparation of recital piece. Written theory assignments will be given periodically.

3RD & 4TH SEMESTERS - Technical development through study of etudes appropriate to student's level of ability; continued development of sightreading skills, preparation of recital piece. Written theory assignments will be given periodically.
