Course Description: Development of writing skills in sentence structure and punctuation; paragraph development; the process of writing, revising and finishing short papers; avoiding common writing errors; and the logical development and organization of ideas. We will write a great deal and in various modes. We will concentrate on generating ideas through journal writing, class discussion and weekly assignments.
