ATTENDANCE POLICY:

Students are expected to attend each class. After <u>four</u> absences, students will be dropped. TOPICS:

Major-minor 5-note scales in all keys; 8-note scale patterns in keys of C,G,D,A,E; I-V7-I chord progression in all major keys; continued development of sightreading skills; preparation of recital piece. Written theory assignments will be given periodically.

Students will work both together as a group and individually with the instructor.
