

GUIDELINES FOR MADRIGAL SINGERS

- 1. Admission into the class is by audition, which takes place during the first week of each semester. You will be expected to sing your part in a mixed quartet.
- 2. Attendance depends upon whether or not you are enrolled as a full or part time student, or are singing as an adult and therefore, can only attend night rehearsals.
 - a. Full time students are expected to attend all rehearsals, (five per week), with possibility of one excused rehearsal per week for people who have tyrannical employers.
 - b. Evening students must attend two rehearsals per week.(Either day or night rehearsals.)
- 3. Membership in the community chorus is required of all madrigal choir members.
 - 4. The madrigal choir performs as many as fifteen performances each semester. Every member is expected to attend every performance. If a member misses two performances during the semester, I will assume that such a person is really overloaded with other activities, and should not continue as a member of KRCS Madrigal Singers.
