

Madera / Oakhurst Vice President Proposal and Organizational Structure

Attached are two possible organizational models for review.

Option A

- full administrative complement, that includes centers' Vice President, Dean of Students and Dean of Instruction
- associate business manager is limited to 21 hours a week, to provide budget oversight (for general and grant funds), including managing plant/campus operations staff
- 3 divisions representatives - Division I Humanities – (12) English, Communication, Philosophy, Foreign Language, Art, History, Music, Photo, Poly. Sci., Sociology; Division II Science and Math (8) – Chemistry, Biology, Geography, Math, Maintenance Mech., Criminology; Division III Health, Student Services, and Business (9) – Nursing, P.E., Counselors, Business, Child Dev., Psychology, FN

Option B

- centers' Vice President and Dean of Instruction
- existing Dean of Students moves to Reedley College, however, still manages “all” campus sites
- associate business manager is limited to 21 hours a week, to provide budget oversight (for general and grant funds), including managing plant/campus operations staff
- 3 divisions representatives - Division I Humanities – (12) English, Communication, Philosophy, Foreign Language, Art, History, Music, Photo, Poly. Sci., Sociology; Division II Science and Math (8) – Chemistry, Biology, Geography, Math, Maintenance Mech., Criminology; Division III Health, Student Services, and Business (9) – Nursing, P.E., Counselors, Business, Child Dev., Psychology, FN

- Providing equal or similar educational services as other college campus sites


Preference
