



## **Week 2: Important Transfer Information for Students Transferring Spring 2018**

### CSU's

Several CSU's are accepting applications for the Spring 2018 term. The application filing period is August 1st – 31st. Clovis Community College is offering a CSU application workshop on August 29 at 1pm. The application can be completed on [www.calstate.edu/apply](http://www.calstate.edu/apply) website.

Make sure to have all official transcripts from all colleges attended, AP scores, etc. sent to the Universities by the date requested for the University you apply to.

\* CSU Fresno will accept applications but they need to meet the criteria listed below.

*California State University, Fresno is accepting admission applications from upper-division transfer applicants who have or will have received their Associates for Transfer Degree (ADT) by the end of fall 2017. The application filing period is August 1 – August 31, 2017. Students can apply online at [www.calstate.edu/apply](http://www.calstate.edu/apply). Fresno State is impacted at the transfer level and will implement heightened admission criteria. Due to limited space availability, the GPA requirement will be determined based on the number of applications received. The recommended GPA for applying is 2.5. All official documents need to be at CSU Fresno by Friday, September 15th.*



## **Week 2: Important Transfer Information for Students Transferring Spring 2018**

*An applicant must meet the admission GPA requirement with all transferable grades through summer 2017. Students who do not meet the GPA requirement at the time of review will NOT be considered for admission. Students who do meet the admission GPA by the end of summer 2017 can use fall 2017 in-progress courses to ensure the Foundation area and/or 60 transferable unit minimum is met in order to complete their ADT.\**
