4.01 MegaPlan Update... Michelle Stricker	Renee Craig-Marius was present to provide an update. The state now wants us to look at how we leverage our resources for student success. Rough draft of the information, data is not complete because we are not done with the academic year. Completion throughout the summer, with assistance from Janice. 100 words - front facing plan that goes to the state that shows what we will be doing. Our back-facing plan will be specific on what we are working on and what will tie us to the outcome. The goals listed came from the campus. Will ask the Deans for support to have instructional faculty for feedback. Plan to bring back in September for first read.
4.02 Madera Mascot...Dr. Caldwell	Madera ASG has been actively working on identification and recommendation for a Mascot. A formal recommendation submitted to Dr. Caldwell. Go Mountain Lions! Black and Gold. Dr. Caldwell shared this information at the BOT meeting in OCCC; and fully supported by our Chancellor.
4.03 ISS/IEPI Update...Janice Offenbach	Every year we set a goal, a one-year goal and a six-year goal, aspirational goals. It is recommended through the colleges - how can we do better? – it will also tell us in six year, and how our scorecard will change. We need to look at both, ISS and IEPI, and know what will then match the scorecard in the future. Must be out by June 15.
4.04 Scorecard Update...Janice Offenbach	Janice gave an update to show we are today and share the Institutional Set Standards (ISS). College profile reflects 15-16 students only. Any questions or concern when looking at the scorecard? – NONE Will be presenting the scorecard to the BOT in June. ESL – looking at the students who started at a remedial level and went into a transfer level in the same discipline. Completely restructured ESL went from 6 levels below. This scorecard reflects all of the students who started in 2010 who never intended to go into degree applicable courses. Janice has already completed longitudinal study. It will be revised for accuracy keeping a percentage of how many students are transferring and following through.
4.05 17-18 Advanced Placement...Emily Berg	Presented by Erica Murrieta to Academic Senate on 3/14 as an informational item from the transfer center. This information not been updated for a while, no substantiate changes. Catalog informational item.
4.06 Military Credit, New Language for 07-18 Catalog...Emily Berg	Presented by Gracie Spear on behalf of Sue Vang, to Academic Senate in mid-March. Quite a lot of discussion at Academic Senate, about what RC will award, the way it's written (listed) is not clarified, how would the counselors look at that?
