Monday, August 14	Start of the Fall 2017 semester
Friday, August 25	Last day to register for a full-term class in person
Sunday, August 27	Last day to drop a full-term course for a refund
Friday, September 1	Last day to drop a full-term class to avoid a "W" in person
Sunday, September 3	Last day to drop a full-term class to avoid a "W" on WebAdvisor
Friday, September 8	Last day to change a class to/from Pass/No-Pass grading basis
Friday, October 13	Last day to drop a full-term class (letter grades will be assigned after this point)
Monday, October 16	Fall short-term classes, second nine weeks begin

# ***Your College TO-DO List:***

## **Before School Starts:**

- ✓ Check Email: Make sure your SCCCD email is activated and you are checking it regularly. All communications from the college will go to that email.
- ✓ Log into WebAdvisor: Check your class schedule and see where you are on waitlists.
- ✓ Textbooks: Buy/rent your Textbooks, school supplies, and any other materials you need to be ready for classes.
- ✓ Parking Permit: Buy a parking permit early to avoid long lines and improve your chances of getting to class early.
- ✓ Tiger One Card: Purchase your Tiger One ID card from the business office and take your picture with Student Activities inside the Student Center

## **The First Week Of School:**

- ✓ Parking: Parking the first month can be tricky, so plan on coming early to give yourself time to find a spot. Remember a parking permit does not guarantee a parking space.
- ✓ Do not be late to any class! Classes are full and instructors will drop you from the class to fill any available seats with waitlisted students who are there on time.
- ✓ Waitlists/Walk-Ins: If you are waitlisted in a class or are trying to walk-in to a class be there on time (or early!) and ready to work the first day.

## **All Semester!**

- ✓ Email: Make sure and check your SCCCD account regularly for updates from the college and/or emails from your instructors.
- ✓ WebAdvisor: Check WebAdvisor to make sure you are enrolled in all of your classes. This is especially important if you have added or changed your classes.
- ✓ BlackBoard: Log into your blackboard account regularly to stay up to date with you classes and instructors.
- ✓ Tutorial Services: Don't wait until you are in trouble in one of your classes to look for help. Sign up for tutorial assistance at one of the several tutorial resources on campus.
- ✓ Counseling: Schedule an appointment on eSARS to meet with a counselor early in the semester. Your counselor can help you create a Student Education Plan (SEP), discuss academic goal(s), refer you to services and programs, and have any additional questions answered.

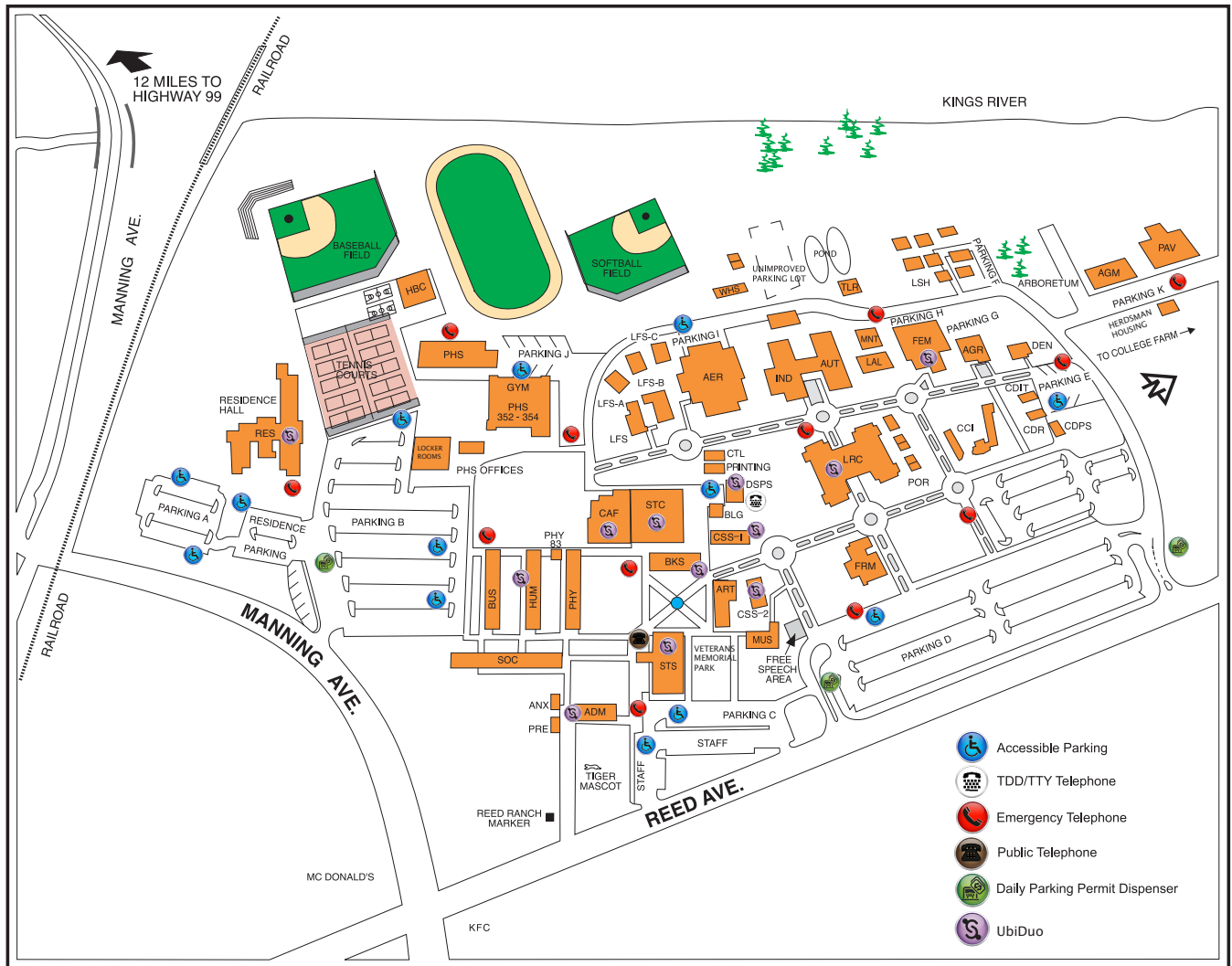
### **PAYING YOUR FEES**
