- Provides a performance measurement system for CA Community Colleges
- Provides transparency and accountability
- Requires annual review with board of trustees


# Changes in this year's review of Student Success Scorecard 

- Districtwide data points added in addition to FCC, RC/ CCC, statewide
- New metric added


## 2017 Student Cohort

- Cohorts are based on students who have valid SSN
- The 2017 student cohort was tracked for six years starting 2010-2011 through 2015-2016.
- Clovis Community College is included as part of the Reedley College Scorecard. The 2017 scorecard includes data from 2010 when Clovis was still a center under Reedley College.
- This cohort began enrollment in 2010-2011 during continued state budget cuts.
- At State Center Community College District, the percentage of first-time cohort students unprepared for college has increased.
o In this year's scorecard, 79\% of first-time cohort students at FCC and 77\% at RC enter unprepared* for college compared to 76\%last year for both colleges.
o Statewide, 76\% of all students at CA community colleges enter unprepared compared to 75\%last year.

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## Transfer Level Achievement

- New metric for 2017 Scorecard
- Transfer Level Achievement (TLA) in two areas: Math \& English
- TLA determines how many students who qualify for the Scorecard completion cohort in their first year then go on to complete a transfer level math or English course during a fixed time period of one or two years
- Starting with next year, Clovis Community College will have separate data for this metric due to shorter term cohorts (time for cohort to reach the outcome is set at 1 and 2 years).


## \% of students who completed Transfer Level English



Definition: The percent of first-time students in 2014-15 who complete 6 units and attempt any English in their first year who complete a transfer-level course in English in their first or second year.

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## \% of students who completed Transfer Level Math


Year 2 (Cumulative)


Definition: The percent of first-time students in 2014-15 who complete 6 units and attempt any Math in their first year who complete a transfer-level course in Math in their first or second year.


## 3 categories in each COMPLETION metric

OVERALL: Student attempted any level of Math or English in the first three years COLLEGE PREPARED: Student's lowest course attempted in Math and/ or English was college level UNPREPARED FOR COLLEGE: Student's lowest course attempted in Math and/ or English was remedial level

## About the metric:

- This metric was introduced in last year's Scorecard (2016)
- Workers who are maintaining or adding to skillset required for ongoing employment and career advancement
- These students do not earn community college certificates or degrees and do not transfer to a four-year institution
- Most are older students who have workforce experience
