## Background:

The Board of Trustees has an obligation to periodically review and revise its policies, and the administration assists the board in that obligation by bringing forward policies for review.

The current Board Policy 2430, "Delegation of Authority to Chancellor," was adopted in 2003. It is consistent with the relevant law, accreditation standards, and recommendations of the Community College League of California. The administration does not recommend any revisions at this time.

## Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board review Board Policy 2430 with the chancellor in his capacity as professional advisor to the board in policy formation, which will be documented for purposes of demonstrating compliance with Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) Accreditation Standard IV.

## **Delegation of Authority to Chancellor**

The Board delegates to the Chancellor the executive responsibility for administering the policies adopted by the Board and executing all decisions of the Board requiring administrative action.

The Chancellor may delegate any powers and duties entrusted to him or her by the Board including the administration of colleges and centers, but will be specifically responsible to the Board for the execution of such delegated powers and duties.

The Chancellor is empowered to reasonably interpret board policy. In situations where there is no board policy direction, the Chancellor shall have the power to act, but such decisions shall be subject to review by the Board. It is the duty of the Chancellor to inform the Board of such action and to recommend written board policy if one is required.

The Chancellor is expected to perform the duties contained in the Chancellor's job description and fulfill other responsibilities as may be determined in annual goal-setting or evaluation sessions. The job description and goals and objectives for performance shall be developed by Board in consultation with the Chancellor.

The Chancellor shall ensure that all relevant laws and regulations are complied with, and that required reports are submitted in timely fashion.

The Chancellor shall make available any information or give any report requested by the Board as a whole. Individual trustee requests for information shall be met if, in the opinion of the Chancellor, they are not unduly burdensome or distruptive to District operations. Information provided to any trustee shall be available to all trustees.

The Chancellor shall act as the professional advisor to the Board in policy formation.
