

SCCCD CHANCELLOR'S CABINET NOTES

Monday, September 12, 2016, 3:00 p.m.

Accreditation Functional Map	Barbara Hioco and Cyndie Luna presented information regarding the Accreditation Functional Map. Ms. Luna explained the map and how it is designed to work.
Strategic Planning Update	Barbara Hioco reminded everyone that the Strategic Planning Alliance is next Monday, Sept. 19. Reminders will go out tomorrow.
AR 2510 and Roles for Constituents (Please bring your materials from the last meeting.)	Sandra Caldwell gave information on Roles of Constituents in District Decision Making. The difference in committees, workgroups and task forces was discussed. Dr. Caldwell explained how the participatory governance process works and how other items that don't require participatory governance work and how everyone is informed. This is in relation to AR 2510. The document she presented to the group is the final document.
IEPI District Plan	Barbara Hioco reported that the plan is complete and she will get the necessary signatures.
Update on Web Design	Pedro Avila gave a presentation of the re-design of the website. It included examples of the district website as well as individual campuses. It was well received and he will continue the process.
Additional CTE Funding	Carole Goldsmith gave information on the additional CTE funding and how the distribution may work. There was discussion as to the funds being divided among the colleges only or including the district in the distribution. It was agreed that District Educational Services needs support. Dr. Parnell asked the three presidents and Dr. Hioco to meet and discuss this and bring back a recommendation.
CVHEC CEO Summit	This had been discussed previously and there were no questions.
Combined Spring 2017 Convocation	Sandra Caldwell advised the group that they need to decide if they are going to do a combined Spring Convocation or individual campus convocations. The presidents will consider the options and bring it back to chancellor's cabinet for a decision.
CVCF Community Conversation; Community Benefit Organization Capacity (Sept. 22, 3:30 – 5:00 p.m.) ACBO's Walter Star-Robie Award	Dr. Parnell and Rico Guerrero will discuss this and bring it back to chancellor's cabinet if necessary.
	Dr. Parnell asked the group to think about if there is anyone that should be nominated for this award or other awards that come up. He would like the cabinet to think about this as a district wide thing rather than individual campuses.

Classification / Compensation Study	Annette Loria reported that she has been in conversation with Dr. Parnell regarding this matter.
FRISK Training	Annette Loria explained information about this type of training. She asked the group if this is something they are interested in. This training is focused on discipline. The consensus is that this training is good and we should move forward with it.
Police Department	Christine Miktarian reported that they are in need of hiring 5 new employees. Other issues of concern were also discussed. Dr. Parnell reported that work is being done toward solutions to improve the department.
Sponsorships	Lucy Ruiz reported several sponsorships the district is participating in.
Board Policies	Dr. Parnell explained that he wants the chancellor's cabinet to review five policies at a time. He would like to start looking at them in November. Doing a blanket change for name changes was discussed.
