English Associate in Arts for Transfer Degree

This is a transfer degree for English majors. Completion of this major allows students to transfer to CSU as a junior.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, a Bachelors degree in English leads to employment in adult education, remedial education, literacy, and GED teaching. Other fields that employ English majors include counseling, editing, interpreting, translation, and K-12 teaching. A BA in English is also considered a rigorous, complementary education for careers in the legal profession including lawyers, paralegals, judges, and clerks. (Some professions require further certification, testing or degrees.)

To obtain the Associate in Arts Degree in English for Transfer, students must complete the following:

- The major requirements below with grades of 2.0 or better
- A minimum of 60 CSU-transferable units with a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or better.
- Certified completion of either the California State University General Education Breadth pattern (CSU GE), or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC-CSU) pattern general education requirements.
