All prerequisites must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. All coursework in Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, and Chemistry must have been completed within the last five years. Prospective applicants must also take the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) with a minimum score of 62%.

RN 160 is required before beginning the Registered Nursing course sequence.
