A 2.67 minimum cumulative GPA is required to begin the credential major classes.

Effective July 1, 2004, passing the CSET exam (California Subject Exam for Teachers) is required for all teacher candidates.

Passing the CBEST (California Basic Educational Skills Test) is required for credentialing. It is recommended that students take the CBEST after successfully completing Reedley College's ENGL 1A, MATH 10A and MATH 10B.
