A "B" or higher grade in ACCTG 1A or a 2.5 gpa in ACCTG 1A and ACCTG 1B is required in order to take upper division accounting courses at CSU Fresno.

Students selecting the International Business option must successfully demonstrate a working commercial knowledge in a language other than English.

CSU Fresno offers options in Accountancy, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Human Resource Management, Computer Information Systems, International Business, Logistics and Supply Chain Strategies, Management, Marketing, Real Estate and Urban Land Economics, Sports Marketing, and Special (with advisor approval).

Students selecting the Computer Information Systems option may complete IS 47 at Reedley College in lieu of CSU Fresno's IS 51. Students selecting the Entrepreneurship option or the Management option may complete BA 52 at Reedley College in lieu of CSU Fresno's ENTR 81. A "B" or higher grade is required in BA 52 to take upper division classes at CSU Fresno.

Students must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.25 and submit an Option Form to formally declare any option in the Business Administration major. Students may obtain an Option Form from the Craig School of Business Undergraduate Student Services Office located in the Peters Building, Room 185 or online at <u>www.craig.csufresno.edu/Student_Info/USS/</u>. Students may apply for an option in the semester during which they will complete all work needed for enrollment qualification in upper division level business courses.
