Notes: CSU Fresno offers options in: Music as a Liberal Art, Music (Choral/Vocal Emphasis or General Emphasis) Education, Instrumental Performance, Instructional Jazz Performance, Vocal Performance, and Composition.

All students majoring in music are automatically enrolled in the Music major with a Liberal Art option until they have been officially admitted to another music degree option. All entering transfer students must take a diagnostic exam in music theory. Other music degree options have audition or other admission requirements, which must be fulfilled before a student is officially recognized as enrolled in that other option.

All options require piano proficiency. Reedley College recommends students take MUS 20, 21, and 22 to prepare for the exam.

Courses marked (Fall) and (Spring) are usually only offered this semester.
