Notes: CR/NC grading is not accepted for the prerequisite courses in the Nursing major.

\*CHEM 3A is the preferred Chemistry course, however, the Nursing Department will use CHEM 1A as a substitute for the CHEM 3A requirement.

\*\*COMM 8 is the preferred course.

\*\*\*ANTHRO 2/SOC 1A, CHDEV 38/PSY 38, FN 35/FN 40, PHIL 1C/1CH, and PSY 2/2H may be completed at CSUF, but it is highly recommended to complete these courses at Reedley College prior to transfer.

Courses listed in more than one area may only be counted one time.

All eight prerequisites must be completed prior to entry into the RN program. A minimum 3.0 ("B") cumulative grade point average is required in the eight Nursing prerequisite classes. A maximum of two prerequisites may be repeated only <u>once</u> for a better grade. For fall entry all prerequisites must be completed by June, and for spring entry all prerequisites must be completed by the preceding fall semester.

Online, web-based, or distance science and laboratory courses must be approved by the Nursing Admissions Coordinator.

Entry into the RN program is competitive with more applicants than spaces available. Selection is based upon gpa in the eight prerequisite courses and preference is given to recent California residents. Fall and Spring admissions are available. A separate Nursing application must be submitted to the Nursing program.

Nursing Application Filing Period:

Fall admission is March 1-30; applications are available February 1 (subject to change). Spring admission is August 1-31; applications are available July 1 (subject to change).
