COMMERCIAL MUSIC Associate in Science Degree

This program satisfies the Music course requirements for the Associate in Science degree and provides the skills for employment in the music business. Students will be prepared to intern at a recording studio, a post audio production facility, a record label, or a publishing company. Students will be qualified as beginning audio technicians and will be able to set up and run live performance audio systems and small digital and analog multi-track recording systems in venues such as theaters and churches. In addition, students will be prepared for further in depth study of Commercial Music at a four-year college or trade school.
