## Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer - Major \#

## Associate in Arts Degree

The Elementary Teacher Education Associate of Arts for Transfer Degree is designed for students planning to transfer to a four-year university ready to continue for a bachelor's degree in Liberal Studies, Integrated Teacher Education and a preliminary Multiple Subject Elementary Teaching Credential. The Elementary Teacher Education Associate of Arts for Transfer Degree requires completion of 46 units of core courses, one course of 3 units from List $A$, one course of 3 units from List $B$ and two courses of 6 units from List C. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA, including grades of $C$ or higher in each course taken to fulfill the major. The degree will help prepare students to pass the California Subject Exam for Teachers (CSET), required for certification as an elementary education teacher in California. It is recommended that students take and pass the California Basic Education Skills Test (CBEST) exam, required for entry to university-level teacher preparation programs, after completing ENGLISH 1A and MATH 10A. California teaching credential requirements are subject to change; consult with a counselor each semester to ensure compliance with state regulations.

## Student Learning Outcomes

1. Students will apply their knowledge of reading, writing and math at levels that will enable them to pass the California Basic Education Skills Test (CBEST), a requirement for entering an elementary teacher education program.
2. Students will recognize and use critical thinking skills in preparation for teaching at the elementary education level.
3. Students will demonstrate knowledge of social, cultural, environmental, and aesthetic perspectives necessary for teaching at the elementary level.
4. Students will have a personal, academic and elementary teacher education career development plan.
