PROGRAM OF STUDY

Spanish Associate in Arts for Transfer Degree

Effective Term: Fall 2015

The Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer Degree prepares students for transfer to four-year Spanish programs. Students will acquire the Spanish language in a culturally rich environment and will possess the receptive skills (listening and reading) and the productive skills (speaking and writing) necessary to achieve communicative competence in order to pursue more advanced study of Spanish at a CSU campus. The Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer Degree is appropriate for students considering careers in fields such as education, translation and interpretation, business, social services and tourism.

To earn an Associate in Arts in Spanish for Transfer Degree, students must complete 60 semester units of CSU-transferable coursework, CSU-GE Breadth or IGETC requirements and 19-20 semester units within the major. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA, including grades of C or higher in each course taken to fulfill the major. The local graduation requirements are not required for the transfer degree. Students should consult with a counselor when planning to complete the degree for more information on university admission and transfer requirements.
