Course Description:

Studio practice to further develop drawing skills in a variety of media and styles. Fully developed compositions in black and white color. Advanced individual projects allowing the students to explore a theme in depth.

1 Lecture and 3 lab hours for 2 units

Subject prerequisite: Art-3X, Beginning Watercolor or ART-9X Paint OIL/ACR or equivalent

Objectives of the course:

1. Student will be able to work on more advanced techniques and composition; more complex problem solving projects such as themes, multi-media compositions and large scale works.
2. Students will be able to demonstrate ability to complete a more advanced composition requiring more complex solutions.

Course outline:

Students must choose with the approval of the instructor advanced projects requiring complex solutions in the media so agreed upon.

Final grades:

Will be based on portfolio and sketch-book assignments, critiques, outside assignments and final examinations.

Late assignments:

Will receive half credit; no work will be accepted more than one week late.

Tests not taken:

Due to students' illness must be made up within two day of the students' return to class.

Final exam:

Must be taken when scheduled.

Attendance:

Will be taken each class session. If you arrive late, it is your responsibility to inform the instructor after class so that your absence will be changed to a tardy. Three tardies constitute an absence. Two weeks consecutive absence invites automatic drop with reinstatement by formal petition only. After any third absence, students are eligible to be dropped. If a student wishes to drop a class, it is his/her responsibility to initiate the action.
