Due Dates

With so many writing assignments, when papers are due, please hand them in. If you would like my comments before writing them or want to do rewrites, then do two rewrites and move on to the next paper. If you have trouble with deadlines, then this is a time to change that problem. Assignments are due on the dates that I state. If you fail to hand in a paper, do plan to move on when that date passes and not hand onto an assignment that you failed to meet.

Reading Like Writers:

Writers read to learn and imitate how others write. In the readings at the end of each chapter, we have writing samples related to the subject explored in the chapter. If chapter is on paragraph development, then, I invite you to locate topic sentence and observe has writer developed his paragraphs-through example, through explanation, or some other way. How has the writer ended the paragraph and how did the writer begin the writing and conclude it. In the section on sentences, notice how many simple or compound sentences are used, how many past or present tense verbs are used. Where are the prepositional phrases located and how are they attached to the subject and verb. Finally, are there words that you do not know their meanings or how to spell them correctly. By reading, we learn a great deal about how to write and how not to write. Good readers make good writers and good writers are readers. Language is a talent that is honed throughout your life with use and enjoyment. Enjoy it!
