Required text:

Writing Voyage, Fifth Edition, Tyner

Course objective:

Students will write thoughtful, well-organized, thesis-directed essays relatively free of structural or grammatical errors. The course will prepare students for English IA and help them develop writing skills expected of AA degree applicants.

Grading:

A student's final grade will be based on an average of a student's letter grades on essay assignments (one-half of final grade), grammar quizzes (one-fourth) and the final writing examination (one-fourth). A "borderline" grade will be affected (positively or negatively) by a student's class participation and homework efforts.

Attendance:

Regular attendance is expected of all students. Absences in excess of three class meetings may result in a student being dropped from the class.

Writing Assignments:

All writing assignments are to be paragraphed, double-spaced, and computer-generated. Late papers will receive a maximum grade of "C," and papers received more than one week after the due date may not be accepted.
