

II FLORAL DESIGN

SYLLABUS

PLACE: FCC Greenhouse

DAY: Tuesday

Attendance: Regular attendance is required.

Each week a lecture will be presented. Each person is required to take notes as the written exams will be based on the notes taken each week. These exams will be counted as 1/3 of the grade for the class.

Lab work is worth 10 points each week for the hands-on projects constructed during class time. Attendance is required in order to gain points earned doing lab work.

A final written project and hands-on design exam will be given.

Missed Exams: In the event a student misses an exam, provisions must be made with the instructor at the next session to make up the missed exam. It is the responsibility of the student to arrange for the make-up. Failure to do so will result in the student receiving a "zero" for that particular exam.
