ATTENDANCE:

Students are expected to attend each class. After four absences, students will be dropped. TOPICS:

Technical development through study of etudes appropriate to student's level of ability; continued development of sightreading skills, preparation of recital piece. Written theory assignments will be given periodically.

Students will work both together as a group and individually with the instructor.
