

MEETS: Thursday 6:00 - 8:50 p.m.

OBJECTIVE: To develop skills in skinning and mounting birds and mammals. Other techniques such as fish mounting and tanning will be discussed and demonstrated.

REQUIREMENTS: Beginning students:

- A. For a "C" grade:
 - 1 bird museum mount
 - 1 mammal museum mount
 - 2 projects (bird or mammal mount, museum skins, mammal skin, etc.)
- B. For a "B" grade:
 - Complete the requirements for "C" grade, plus
 - 2 additional projects
- C. For an "A" grade:
 - Complete the requirements for a "B" grade, plus
 - 2 additional projects

Advanced students:

- 1 museum mount
- 3 projects
- Grade will be determined on the basis of the number and difficulty of the projects.

ATTENDANCE: Good attendance is required. The lab will be open from 5:00 - 10:00 p.m. on Thursdays. You may work extra time and then take off some lab time (flexible lab hours). Try to plan your projects so that you can complete them in a reasonable time.

BOOK: No book is required.

EQUIPMENT: A dissecting kit or dissecting tools are needed.
