Requirements: Beginning Students:

- A. For a "C" Grade:

 - 1 mammal museum mount
 - 2 projects (bird or mammal mount, museum skin, etc.)
- B. For a "B" Grade:
 - Complete the requirements for a "C" Grade
 - Plus 2 additional projects
- C. For an "A" Grade:
 - Complete the requirements for a "B" Grade
 - Plus 2 additional projects

Advanced Students:

1 museum mount
3 projects
Grade will be determined on the basis of the number and difficulty of the projects.

All projects must be students own work.

Attendance: Good attendance is required. Lab will be open 5:00 – 9:00pm on Thursdays. You may work extra time and then take off some lab time (flexible lab hours). Try to plan your projects so that you can complete them in a reasonable time.
