COURSE DESCRIPTION: Comprehensive baseball skills, game strategy, rules and related topics in preparation for the intercollegiate baseball season.

COURSE OBJECTIVE: Students will be able to understand the rules of NCAA baseball and any rules pertaining to Junior College baseball as set by the California Commission on Athletics. Students will also be expected to understand the offensive and defensive strategies involved in the game of baseball.
