Cooperative Work Experience – Manufacturing Technology

Prerequisite: MFGT 60 or MFGT 80 or MFGT 11

Course Description

Variable Units: 1 – 8 units

This course is designed to provide ongoing support for students while they are engaged in supervised employment, directly related to their major. Students earn units using the following formula: for paid work, 75 hours = 1 unit; for volunteer work, 60 hours = 1 unit. Students may enroll for a maximum of 8 units per semester. Students may earn a total of 16 units in work experience of which only 6 may be in COTR 19G. Note: Repetition of Cooperative Work Experience courses is allowable under Title 5, §55253. PREREQUISITES: Manufacturing Technology 11 or 60 or 80.
