Eligiblity Requirements

To qualify and receive services from the SSS TRiO Program students must:

- 1. Be a U.S. Citizen or a legal resident in the process of establishing residency.
- 2. Be enrolled at Reedley College, Willow International, or Madera
- 3. Have documentation of a verified disability, and
- 4. Have an academic goal of earning an AA/AS degree and/or transfer to a four-year university

Student Support Services is 100% federally funded by the United States Department of Education. The Federal TRiO Programs are educational opportunity outreach programs designed to motivate and support students from disadvantaged backgrounds. TRIO includes six outreach and support programs targeted to serve and assist low income, firstgeneration college, and students with disabilities to progress through the academic pipeline from middle school to post-baccalaureate programs.
