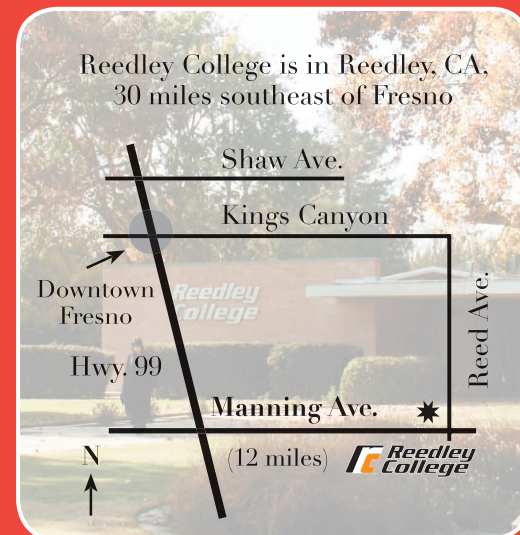

## Mission Statement

Student Support Services (SSS) at Reedley College is designed to provide enrichment services that will alleviate the educational and social barriers which prevent students with disabilities from succeeding at the post-secondary level. Through the delivery of comprehensive academic, social and personal services; the SSS program will promote and increase the retention and transfer rates of students with disabilities.

## Eligibility Requirements

To qualify and receive services from the SSS TRiO Program students must:

1. Be a U.S. Citizen or a legal resident in the process of establishing residency.
2. Be enrolled at Reedley College, Willow International, or Madera
3. Have documentation of a verified disability, and
4. Have an academic goal of earning an AA/AS degree and/or transfer to a four-year university



Student Support Services is 100% federally funded by the United States Department of Education.

The Federal TRiO Programs are educational opportunity outreach programs designed to motivate and support students from disadvantaged backgrounds. TRiO includes six outreach and support programs targeted to serve and assist low income, first-generation college, and students with disabilities to progress through the academic pipeline from middle school to post-baccalaureate programs.
