

STEPS FOR ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION

1

ELIGIBILITY:

You are eligible for admission to Fresno City College or Reedley College if you meet one of these requirements:

- A. 18 years of age by the first day of the semester for which you are applying;
- B. A high school graduate or equivalent (California High School Proficiency Examination or the G.E.D. Test);
- C. Qualify for the High School Enrichment (15%) Program (high school juniors or seniors).

APPLICATION:

- A. Complete ALL QUESTIONS on this application with a No. 2 PENCIL. Do not leave any items blank.
- B. Students with medical concerns should submit an emergency procedure form to the college's Health Services Office to facilitate an emergency response on campus.
- C. Submit completed admission application to the Admissions & Records Office of any of the colleges or centers of the State Center Community College District.

TRANSCRIPTS:

- A. High School - If you have attended high school within the past two years, send two (2) official copies of your high school transcript (with graduation date posted) to the Admissions & Records Office of any of the colleges or centers of the State Center Community College District. Bring one (1) copy to your advising/counseling session.
- B. Other Colleges - Send two (2) official copies of your other college transcripts (with final grades posted) to the Admissions & Records Office of any of the colleges or centers of the State Center Community College District. Bring one (1) copy to your advising/counseling session.
- C. C.H.S.P.E. - If you passed the California High School Proficiency Examination within the past two (2) years, your high school transcript must certify the satisfactory completion of the C.H.S.P.E.
- D. G.E.D. - If you have taken the G.E.D. test within the past two (2) years, send an official copy of your G.E.D. test scores to the Admissions & Records Office of any of the colleges or centers of the State Center Community College District.

ASSESSMENT (PLACEMENT TEST):

ORIENTATION/STUDENT EDUCATIONAL PLAN:

REGISTRATION:

All applicants will be mailed registration information beginning in April for the Summer/Fall registration cycle and beginning in October for the Spring registration cycle. Your registration date will be assigned based upon the date your completed application is received.

FINANCIAL AID: Applications are available on or after JANUARY 2. Internet application is available and encouraged (www.fafsa.ed.gov). See the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for complete information. Students may submit the financial aid application to the Federal Student Aid processing center or to the college financial aid office for processing if not applying on the Internet. Within 2-6 weeks the student will receive the STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR). The college will download and process all SARs for Fresno City College and Reedley College. If you are a California resident you may be eligible for a California Community College Board of Governor's Grant (enrollment fee waiver). Check with the Financial Aid Office for detailed information. NOTE: No person subject to the federal Military Selective Service Act shall be eligible to receive federal financial aid if they have not registered for selective service in accordance with the act. In accordance with Education Code Section 32320 dependents of service-connected disabled or service-connected deceased veterans may be eligible for an enrollment fee waiver.


