RE: Recommended language to be added into RC Committee Operating Agreements

In light of W/I ACCJC Recommendation 1 ("...The Center must develop its own processes related to the development and oversight of instructional programs...and must develop its own processes for support and institutional planning and governance..."), yet with respect for California Education Code and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations as it relates to institutional governance processes as they exist in the California Community College system, we recommend that the Reedley College Academic Senate add the following language to the operating agreements of its committees (Academic Standards, Curriculum, and Equivalency), and recommend to the College Council that this language be added to the operating agreements of all college committees:

According to process, a standing committee simply needs to inform the College Council that it has formed a subcommittee—no ratification/approval/confirmation necessary.
