Summary of Meeting of Chancellor's Cabinet
May 2, 2011

May 3, 2011, Board Agenda	Dr. Villa reviewed the financial aid best practices PowerPoint with Cabinet. Cabinet reviewed the May 3, 2011, board agenda.
AB 515 (Community Colleges Extension Program) Letter of Support	Cabinet discussed AB515. Mr. Rowe stated it was reported at Consultation Council that the unions are against it, because they said it creates two classes of students. Dr. Hioco said the community college CEOs are not supporting this bill. CCLC is in support of the bill.
Budget Implementation Update	Dr. Wright advised Cabinet that the Cost Reduction Implementation team (CRIT) will meet every other week instead of weekly. He had no additional information to report. Dr. Blue recommended that Ron Beeler and PGE representatives met with CRIT to present some information on energy efficiency. Ms. Acosta will contact Mr. Beeler to arrange for a presentation at the May 23 CRIT meeting.
District Resource Allocation Model Work Group	Dr. Blue stated she met with Dr. Wright and Dr. Blackwood to discuss the formation of a working group to begin the dialog on a district resource allocation model. Cabinet recommended the work group consist of the following members: vice chancellor of finance and administration, director of finance, CBOs from the campuses, representative from HR, representative from IT, representative from facilities, two faculty members, one classified, and one student member from each campus, one CSEA member from each campus, one member from SCFT, and one member from SCCCPOA. Dr. Wright will chair the meeting and his assistant Vicki Bustos will record notes for the meeting. Dr. Blue recommended that Shelly Conner participate as an observer. The first meeting will take place at the Clovis Center on May 13, 2011, from 3-5 p.m.
Around the Table	Dr. Blue advised Cabinet that all future cabinet agendas and related materials will be sent electronically on Fridays. Hard copies will no longer be available at cabinet meetings unless there are changes to the agenda. Greg Taylor stated he attended the CCLC conference in Monterey. In addition, he will be attending a meeting with other general counsels in Sacramento on May 4, 2011.

Mr. Rowe provided an update on negotiations.

Dr. Hioco presented information on Reedley College's categorical budget progress report. Reedley College will be hosting a college readiness workshop on May 11, 2011. The Tom West memorial will take place on May 18, 2011, at 3:00 p.m.
